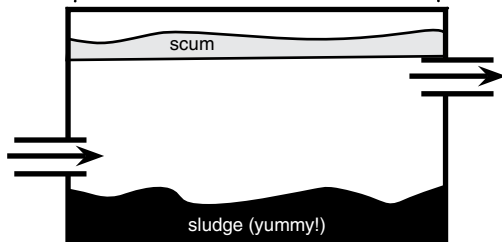
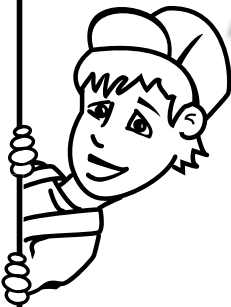
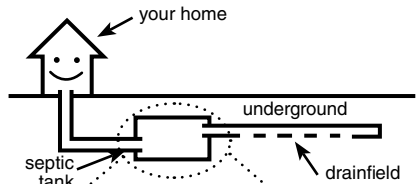
Hi, I'm **Septic Sam** and this is my friend **Mike Robe**. Do you know what happens when you put something down your bathroom drain or toilet?

The Science of a Septic Tank

Does your home have a septic system? If it does, when you put something down the drain or flush your toilet, it travels down pipes, out of your house and into a septic tank.
