RESCIND OF EVACUATION ALERT – CAEN ROAD

The **Evacuation Alert** issued by the Columbia Shuswap Regional District on April 5, 2019, for two properties located on Caen Road in Sorrento BC has been rescinded:

2807 Caen Road

2809 Caen Road

The likelihood of sudden slope instability resulting from freshet peak flows has passed for this season. Potentially unstable trees along the west bank of the creek remains a significant hazard, but the gully erosion processes are much less dynamic than during the spring freshet period. Occupants of these properties should continue to:

- Monitor the creek and report any significant changes.
- Monitor the gully sidewalls for further erosion, bank failures or deformation at the gully crest.
- Avoid the zone five (5) metres from the crest edge of the creek channel.
- Refer to the recommendations within the Monitoring Results and Summary Recommendations report by Westrek Geotechnical Services Ltd., dated October 6, 2018 as it relates to specific properties.
